SCGS 2022–23 International Series!

Meng Su (China) Saturday, October 15, 2022 – 7:30 PM



Multifaceted guitarist Meng Su is captivating audiences around the world with her stunning virtuosity and refined artistry. New York Concert Review called her performance "seemingly effortless and stunningly polished.... Add to that a beautiful – and fashionable! – stage presence, and she is poised to be in high demand". Meng Su's performances and recordings have impressed the public with "an ability and artistry that exceeds her years." (Baltimore Sun) Her debut solo recording "Meng," released in 2016 was called "aweinspiring" and "this year's finest debut by far" by Classical Guitar Magazine. In addition to her busy solo career, Meng Su is an avid chamber musician who tours regularly in the Beijing Guitar Duo and as a soloist with orchestras. Ms. Su has performed in over 30 countries around the world in halls such as the Concertgebouw, Palau de Musica, Tchaikovsky Hall and the National Centre for the Performing Arts in Beijing. Meng Su has won first-prize in numerous international competitions in Europe, Asia and America,

including the prestigious Parkening International Guitar competition in 2015. She obtained a Master's Degree and an Artist Diploma with legendary guitarist Manuel Barrueco at the Peabody Conservatory and in 2018, was presented the award of Outstanding Recent Graduate. Meng Su was also awarded the 2022 Mary Sawyers Baker Award in Music from the Greater Baltimore Cultural Alliance.

René Izquierdo (Cuba) Saturday, November 19, 2022 – 7:30 PM



Cuban-born René Izquierdo is a unique artist and passionate educator whose career has been dedicated to inspiring individuals and connecting communities. Whether passionately performing on stage, devotedly mentoring his students, fund-raising, or leading community outreach, René's multi-faceted approach endeavors to continue creating experiences that enrich people's lives and add beauty to our world. Through his "unforgettable versatility, sensitivity and sublime musicianship" (Classical Guitar Magazine), René has firmly established himself as one of the world's classical guitar virtuosos. He is celebrated for his ability to weave an unparalleled technical command of his instrument with his gift of storytelling, accomplishing an intimate musical experience with his audience. He has performed to critical acclaim, touring extensively throughout the Americas, Europe, and Asia. He is frequently invited by renowned

festivals and institutions, having played at stages such as Carnegie Hall in New York, Manaus Opera House in Brazil, and the National Recital Hall in Taiwan. René heads the guitar program at the University of Wisconsin, Milwaukee, Peck School of the Arts where is a professor of Classical Guitar and also director of the Guitar Ensemble.

David Russell (Scotland/Spain) Saturday, March 11, 2023 – 7:30 PM



Classical guitarist David Russell is world renowned for his superb musicianship and inspired artistry, having earned the highest praise from audiences and critics alike. His many awards and honors include the 2005 Grammy Award for Best Instrumental Solo Recording, 2014 Honorary Doctorate in Music from University of Arizona, 2018 GFA Hall of Fame inductee. In 2003 he was bestowed the great honor of being made "adopted son" of Es Migjorn, the town in Minorca where he grew up. Later the town named a street after him, "Avinguda David Russell". In recognition of his great talent and international career, he was named a Fellow of The Royal Academy of Music in London in 1997 and during his studies at the Royal Academy, he won twice the Julian Bream Guitar Prize. Later he won numerous international competitions, including the Andrés Segovia Competition, the José Ramírez Competition and Spain's prestigious Francisco Tárrega Competition. David Russell spends his time touring the world,

appearing regularly at prestigious halls in main cities, such as New York, London, Tokyo, Los Angeles, Madrid, Toronto or Rome. Concert-goers everywhere are in awe of his musical genius and inspired by his captivating stage presence. His love of his craft resonates through his flawless and seemingly effortless performance. The attention to detail and provocative lyrical phrasing suggest an innate understanding of what each individual composer was working to achieve, bringing to each piece a sense of adventure. A prolific recording artist, his collection includes seventeen CDs with Telarc International.

Brasil Guitar Duo (Brazil) Saturday, May 6, 2023 – 7:30 PM



The **Brasil Guitar Duo**, hailed by Classical Guitar magazine for its "maturity of musicianship and technical virtuosity," is equally at home on a classical or a world-music series or performing a concerto with orchestra. João Luiz and Douglas Lora met in São Paulo as teenage guitar students and their successful partnership of over twenty years results from their innovative programming— which features a seamless blend of traditional and Brazilian works—leading to a busy global touring schedule and a growing catalogue of critically acclaimed recordings garnering two Latin Grammy nominations. João Luiz received his Master's degree from Mannes College the New School for Music and earned a doctoral degree from the Manhattan School of Music where he studied with David Leisner. João is the director of chamber music at CUNY-Hunter College, and the head of guitar studies at Stony Brook University. The Duo actively strives to expand the repertoire for two guitars, with Lora contributing works of his own and Luiz arranging both classical and Brazilian music.






